Visit Inspiring Places, Temples & Caves



While staying at the Academy, there will be time to visit several interesting places, such as Karla and Bhaja Caves, located either side of the Academy. These fascinating rock-cut cave-temples date back to the 2nd century BC and are among the oldest and finest examples of rock-cut temple art in the whole of India.

The commercial capital of India, Mumbai, is the place to shop. Just 2 hours drive from VA, Mumbai is famous for the Gateway of India and Elephanta Caves. The Gateway is located on the waterfront in South Mumbai and the Elephanta Caves are on Elephanta island, 10km by boat. These rock-cut cave-temples, date back to the 5th century BC.

Pune is a short train journey from VA. Pune's pride is the Parvati Temple, which has beautiful panoramic views of the city.

These are just a few of the things to see and do; there will be many more sights and surprises waiting for you.
